Naeem Khan started his career working for the house of Halston and in 2003 launched his own label. The collections are now sold worldwide in luxury stores such as Neman Marcus and Barney's New York. Naeem's ornate Indian influenced designs are beloved by red carpet celebrities including Beyonce, Carrie Underwood, Eva Longoria, and Brooke Shields. He has also made several couture designs for the First Lady Michelle Obama, including her gown recently worn at the White House Correspondence dinner.
